Enjoyed your valuable Hong Kong comments.

Here are notes on new things and followups.

1. Thursday, 7/28. there will be visitors to your place [redacted]
 [redacted] It is Project Common Bond, run by Tuesday's Children (as in Tues 9/11), a program for young people from around the world whose lives have been specifically impacted by terrorism. The group includes several from 9/11 and a number from 10 other countries. They're working in groups with various therapists, conflict resolution trainers and others to make their ways, make connections and understandings, forge bonds and bring good things home. They were told they are meeting with a senior official in yr bldg and are obviously hoping it's you. [redacted]
